## Admission requirements

ERASMUS+ students applying for a given study period at the University of Applied Sciences in Nysa are requested to send the following documents to the International Cooperation Office:

- Confirmation of student's nomination
- Application Form
- Learning Agreement
- Transcript of Records
- Copy of ID document/passport
- Copy of the certificate of health insurance
- 2 photos passport size

### Application Deadlines:

Autumn Semester: 15th June

Spring Semester: 15th November



### Dormitory:

Erasmus+ students coming to Nysa will be accommodated at the University Dormitory. Nevertheless, the number of places is limited and priority will be given to the students who sent all required application documents as the first ones, according to the rule "first come, first served". Each room has a free access to the internet. Two study rooms, computer room, TV, tennis table, three kitchens and a laundry is available.

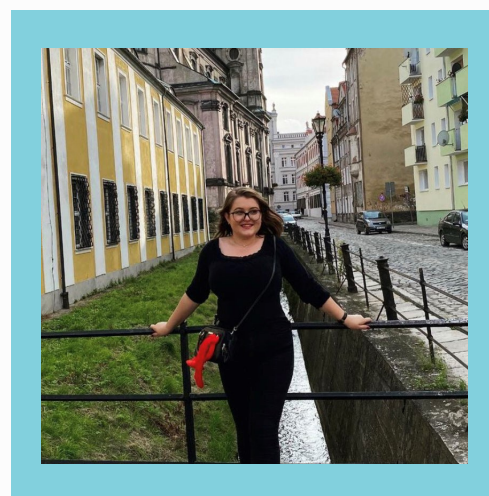
I will always be thankful for having spent my Erasmus+ in beautiful Nysa. If you have the opportunity for this city, I encourage you to take it, you won't regret it :)
